Nancy's Indian name was So-wah-nah-ke-ke-quah. She was of the Peoria Tribe.

She was married to Henry Stand. Henry was half-Wyandot and half-Shawnee and was reared by his uncle, John Whitewing, "Mud Eater" of the Small Turtle clan of Wyandots.

Nancy & Henry's children were: Matilda "Tillie," Leander, Raymond, & Wilson.

On May 2, 1910, Henry, age 45, & Nancy, 46, lived in Peoria, Ottawa Co, OK where he did odd jobs to help support the family. They had been married 21 years. Nancy had given birth to 7 children, but only 5 were alive. Their children were shown as Matilda, age 19; Leander, 16, Raymond, 11, & Wilson, 8.

On January 26/27, 1920, Nancy, age 55, with her married daughter, Matilda M. McQuillin, age 29, and her husband, Appelon E., age 31, in Peoria, OK. They had a daughter, Ida L, age 7. Nancy was shown as a widow, however, her husband was still living. Appelon was a miner.

OKLA.

Miami, Okla., April 19. - Mrs. Nancy Stand, 84-year-old Indian woman, died at 3 o'clock this morning at her home in the Promenade district, east of Miami. She had been a resident of that area most of her life.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Alex Beaver and Mrs. Maggie Boyd, both of near Miami; two sons, Raymond Stand of near Miami and Wilbur Stand of Miami; 20 grandchildren and 24 great-grandchildren. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 o'clock Wednesday morning at the Indian Baptist Mission in the Promenade district, with the Rev. Thomas J. Wamego officiating.

Burial will be in the Peoria cemetery under the direction of the Cooper funeral home."
